ISO 20121 is a management system standard that has been designed to help organisations in the events industry improve the sustainability of their event related activities, products and services. In simple terms, ISO 20121 describes the building blocks of a management system that will help any event related organisation to:

- Continue to be financially & operationally successful
- Become more socially responsible
- Reduce its environmental footprint

ISO 20121 applies to all types and sizes of organisation involved in the events industry – from caterers, lighting and sound engineers, security companies, stage builders and venues to independent event organisers and corporate and public sector event teams. Organisations that successfully implement the standard are able to seek independent recognition of their achievement through a process called 'Certification'.
